Dear Commissioners,

At the court's request, I write to apprise you of the attached news release issued today concerning, among other things, any petition or petitions that might be filed challenging electoral maps that you have certified to the Secretary of State. As explained in the news release, the court requires "electronic submission" of any such petition or petitions and related documents, to be uploaded at a specially dedicated judicial branch Web site, <http://www.courts.ca.gov/redistricting.htm>. Within 24 hours thereafter, each such document also must be received in hard copy, and filed, at the court's San Francisco office.

In order to publicize the court's requirement of electronic submission of such petitions and related documents, the court requests that you post, as soon as possible, a link to this news release in a conspicuous place on your Web site, under a heading such as "Electronic submission of petitions challenging maps certified by the Commission." The link for the news release, which in turn provides a link to the court's administrative order, is as follows: <http://www.courts.ca.gov/redistricting.htm>. The court has posted a similar notice and link on the judicial branch Web site.
